Details of the NGO - Centre for Social Service (CSS) was started in 2004 as a Welfare Organization. CSS aims to educate and empower orphan, semi-orphan, socially and economically underprivileged girls. CSS strongly feels economic independence through education and livelihood training is one of the best ways for women empowerment and education should be accessible to all irrespective of gender, economic or social status.

CSS has three major projects running in Hyderabad.

- 1. **CSS Residential Home for Orphan and underprivileged girls** Under this project, 70 orphan and single parent girls are provided safe and secure accommodation with all basic amenities and education. All the girls are studying in various courses like Commerce, Science, Engineering, B Pharmacy, MBA, accounting, and Schooling. So far more than 200 girls have passed out of CSS Home and are well settled in their lives. Three girls have completed their Masters in USA and working. Two girls are currently pursuing their Masters in USA now.
- 2. **CSS Free English Medium School for Girls** Under this ,550 socially and economically underprivileged girls are given free education from Nursery to 10th grade. The school was started in 2009. Students come from surrounding under-privileged colonies. All the students are first generation school goers in their families. Most of the parents are uneducated and work as daily labourers, auto drivers etc. They have come from villages to the city in search of livelihood and settled in HayathNagar area. The school runs with the help of donations. No monthly fee is collected from the students and education is provided free of cost.
- 3. **Dr. Lakshmi Ganga Swayam Sakthi Project** Under this program women in distress situations who come to CSS are counselled and helped to rebuild their lives. Free vocational training in livelihood skills is provided to help women become economically independent.

Proposal to include secondary education

Support is requested for CSS Free School expansion to include 11th and 12th grades.

As an organization we strive to not only provide the basic primary education through our school but also focus on providing access to higher education and opportunities to obtain professional degrees to disadvantaged students which will help them secure a job. Plans are afoot to start 11th and 12th grades in the school. This will help in extending the academic program of the students. Intermediate bridges High School education and College education and helps in the smooth transition of students into higher education. This will also enable students who cannot continue their education after 10th grade because of economic constraints to study up to Intermediate and seek gainful employment.

Infrastructure development details - CSS has three hundred square yards of vacant land in the school in which the proposed Intermediate building will be constructed and developed.

Total area of construction - 8000 Sqft

- Foundation plus three floors
- Each floor with two rooms and two bathrooms
- Total six rooms, one hall and 6 bathrooms
- Approximate cost of construction for one sqft is Rs 2000/-
- Total construction cost Rs.1,64,00,000/ (\$ 205,000)
- Average cost for classroom sponsorship [including staffing and infrastructure]-\$10,000
